

We encourage you to complete the ballot, answering yes or no. And please make your choices for Board members... this is a real election.

Meanwhile, our friends at Neighbors Helping Neighbors (NHN) Club have some exciting news: NHN has put together a STONE RIDGE PHONE DIRECTORY!!! Since we haven't had one for about three years, we decided to do it ourselves.
